

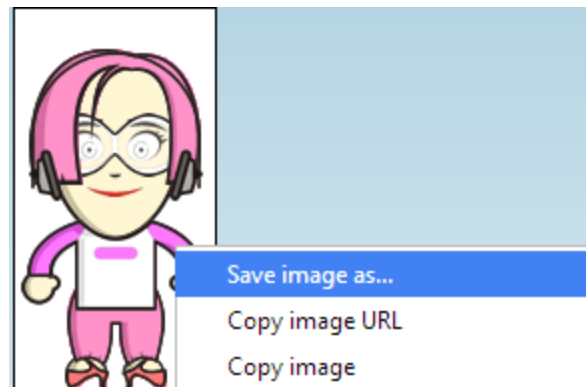
Online tools for creating avatars
